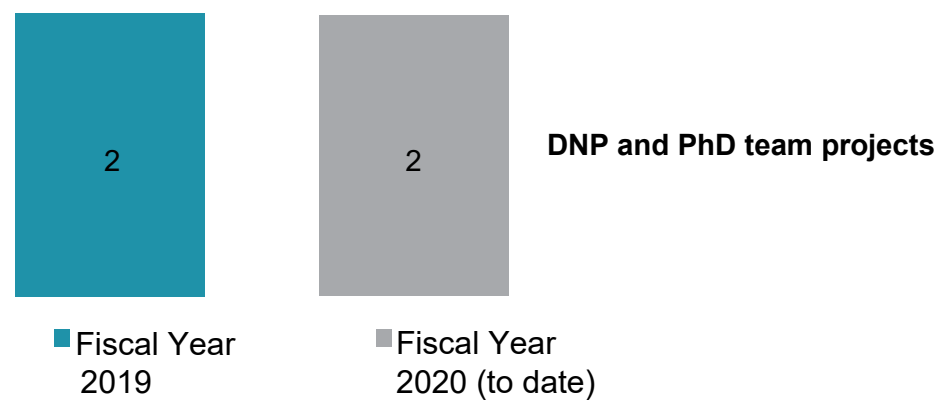

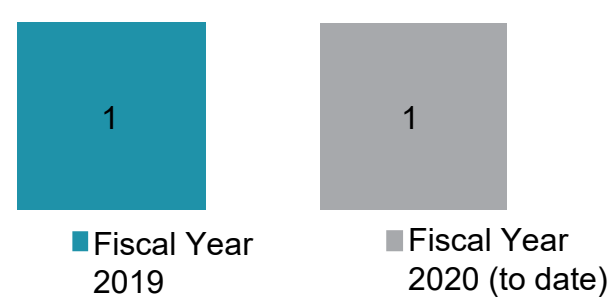

Goal: Increase DNP and PhD team projects by one project every year (FY19: 1, FY20: 2, FY21: 3, FY22: 4)

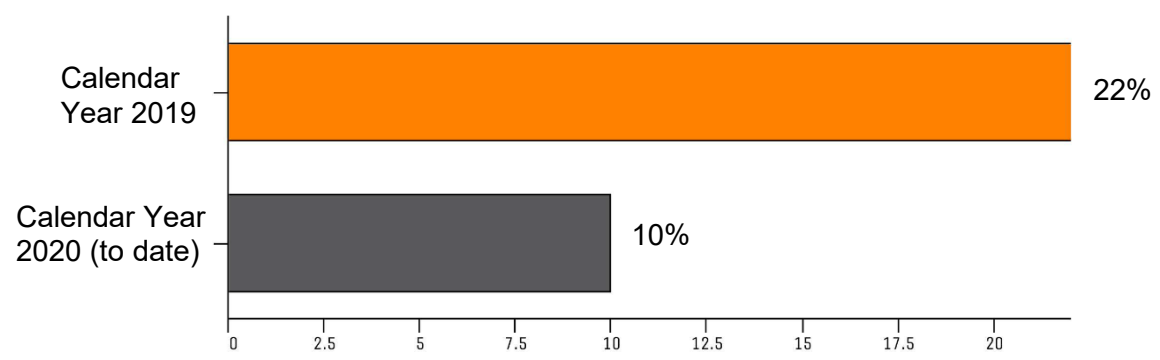

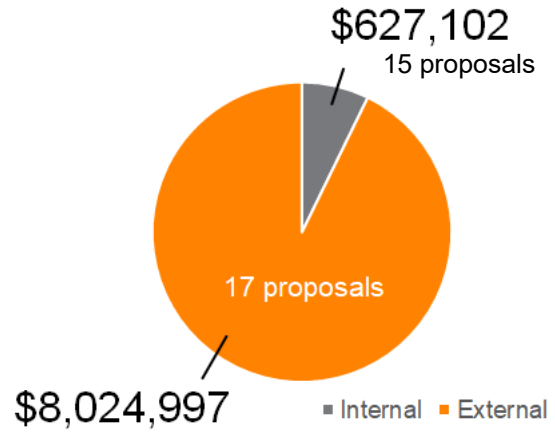

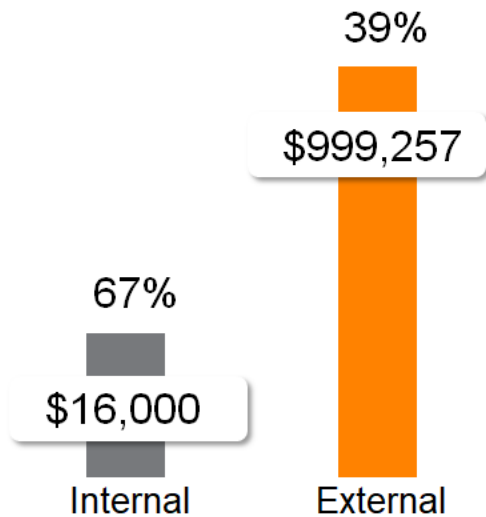


FY 2020 (YTD 2/6/2020)



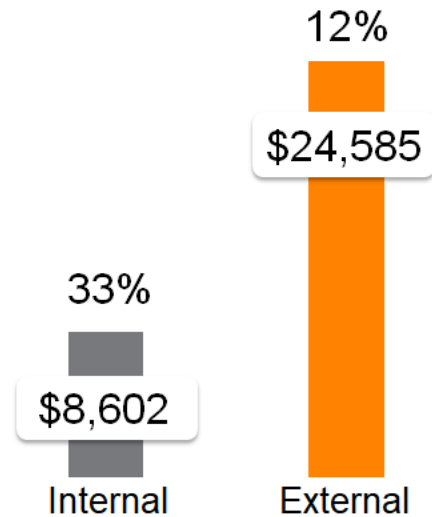
New Proposals Funded
