Students seeking admission to the FNP graduate certificate program must have completed three prerequisite courses (or equivalent courses at another institution) **prior** to entry into FNP Didactic/Clinical I:

- N639 – Advanced Health/Physical Assessment and Diagnostic Reasoning
- N648 – Advanced Clinical Pharmacology
- N649 – Advanced Pathophysiology for Nursing Practice

- **Prerequisites must be within 5 years of entry into the program.** Transcripts must be reviewed and courses verified to ensure compliance with prerequisite requirements.
